Reminders

- **THIS IS REC BALL** This is about the community of kids learning how to play baseball/softball and build relationships with their friends. If it is not intense enough for you, go find a travel team and focus on that.
- IT IS NOT THAT SERIOUS You are the biggest example of how to present yourself on a playing field to the kids on your team, as well as the team you are playing. Be an adult. There is ZERO reason to yell, scream, argue or fight with the umpires, opposing coaches or parents.
- NO ONE CARES that you can coach a team to an undefeated season without giving up any runs. If your division had a perfect season, every team would be 5-5 and ALL kids would come back to play again next year.
- A 10-0 SEASON IS ABOUT YOU AND NOT ABOUT YOUR PLAYERS. You don't have to coach to lose, and you should strive to win, but an undefeated season only matters to you, the adults.
- **DEVELOP** <u>ALL</u> **OF YOUR PLAYERS**. If a kid wants to pitch, make it happen. Don't bat the same kid last every game. Making the worst kids on your team a little bit better is more important than making your best kid a little bit better.
- THIS IS ABOUT HAVING FUN and spending quality time with your kid(s).

Opening Night


- Opening Night Ceremony February 23

Official LCBSA Baseball Tournament Teams

<u>Cooperstown 12U Team(s)</u>

 Cooperstown 12U baseball team already mobilizing, tryouts slated for mid-late January / early February.

6U-11U Teams:

- All eligible players will be invited to participate in Tournament Team tryouts.
- Additional financial and time commitment required.
- TT manager selection to be held in March / early April (excluding 12U).
- TT tryouts to be held in mid-late April (excluding 12U).
- First tournament usually held during Memorial Day weekend.
- Potential for 2 teams depending on tryout volume/commitment.
- <u>VERY</u> important to have manager participation in selection process.





Official LCBSA Softball Tournament Teams

• 8U, 10U, 12U and 14U Softball Teams

- All eligible players are invited to participate in Tournament Team tryouts.
- Additional financial and time commitment required.
- TT manager selection occurs in late April.
- TT tryouts are held in early May.
- Tournaments begin as early as May 10 (dates and tourneys TBD)
- District and State Tournaments in late June/early July

Background Checks - Required

- Required for both Baseball/Softball coaches, umpires as well as highly involved volunteers
 - Baseball will leverage the same online process as last year
 - Softball has a new process, referred to as "Softball Coaching Registration" process
 - Board Members and Umps must also complete

Live Scan – AB 506

- CA State Requirement for all Youth Organization Volunteers
 Abuse prevention law and training
- All managers, coaches and volunteers must complete (in additional to the other sport-specific trainings - concussion, SafeSport, etc.):
 - Live Scan / Fingerprint background check
 - Online AB 506 Training
- You will receive an email with the pre-populated LCBSA Live Scan Request Form and link to the online training
- You are responsible for the Live Scan application fee about \$30
- January 27, 2024 LCBSA Field Clean Up Day
 a Live Scan operator will be at LCBSA if you don't do it before then

- Complete your background check (All Volunteers)
- Do three (5) homework assignments:
 - 1. Take the <u>Concussion in Sports</u> online course (All)
 - 2. Take the <u>Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention</u> online course (Baseball Only)
 - 3. Take the <u>CA Child Safety Training</u> online course (Baseball Only)
 - 4. Complete Live Scan (All)
 - 5. SafeSport (Softball Only)
- Draft Your Team: GM's to communicate prep steps, process, and date
- Secure your Sponsor
- Look out for "Field Prep Day" and encourage parent participation
- Pick-Up your baseballs: GM's to communicate when and how
- Get Started, Be Safe and Have Fun!!!
